



Future Cheer is proud to present “Point of View,” the innovative approach to helping coaches TRULY understand the Future Cheer philosophies and methodologies of scoring routines. It allows you to understand what our judges look for, how they evaluate things, and how we work together to get the correct results every time. It also looks at rules, legalities, current trends in assessment and even lets you in on some of the assessment options that FC is considering for future use, so you can always stay on top of what’s happening next!

Is this a Judges Certification or an Educational Course?

It can be one or both, depending on the track you choose. Some students will take the course simply because it helps them to become better coaches and choreographers when they understand the evaluation process. Others will take the course because they may actually want to become a judge! Top performers within the course may be asked to “shadow judge” at an FC event to get “real world” experience (pending availability.) Our top shadow panelists can then become eligible to judge at FC events around the UK! So, while “Point of View” is not necessarily judges’ qualification, but it CAN BE if you meet certain criteria. At the very least, you’ll leave the course with an excellent understanding of how to better coach your team for successful competitive routines!

Who should attend this course?

The “Point of View” Judges Course is designed for coaches, choreographers, and potential judges who will benefit from a better understanding of the evaluation process. Minimum age to sit this course is 16.

What does the course cover?

This course will address elements involved with Panel Judging for cheer and dance at Future Cheer. Elements of safety judging are addressed, but the focus is on Panel evaluation processes. The course instruction includes interactive classroom discussions and activities, video instruction, and real-time scoring on actual scoresheets with actual routines. You will receive written feedback on your course work and a certificate of course completion. If you progress through shadow judging and FC interviews as noted above, you will be issued an official FC Judges Certification.

What do I send in to register?

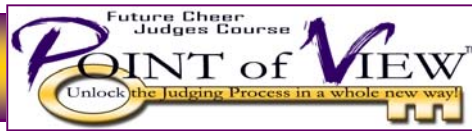
