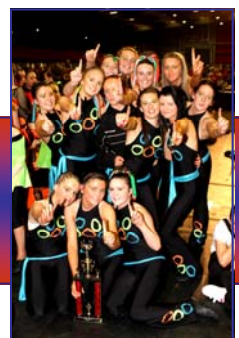

# 2009-2010 Competition Divisions

## IMPORTANT DIVISION NOTES NEW FOR 2009-2010:

- ◆ Athlete age for the entire 2009-2010 season is determined by their age as of **31 AUGUST 2009**.
- ◆ Minimum number of athletes to constitute a cheer team or dance team is now 7 (seven).
- ◆ Pee-Wee divisions are now called "Mini" with the division code "M."
- ◆ See the 2009-2010 FUTURE CHEER RULEBOOK (available online mid-July 2009) for further information on divisions, division guidelines, age requirements and recommendations, crossover protocol, etc.

### How do I know my Division Code for my registration form?

Your team rosters and payment calculation form will ask you to note the division code that applies to your entry for each team and/or stunt group.

#### **For Stunt Groups, Partner Stunts, and Dance Teams:**

Division codes are noted in the division/age grid in the "CODES" column. For example, Senior Jazz division is noted as "SJ". Please use these codes with your registration paperwork.

#### **For Cheer Teams:**

Information in the chart above will assist you in writing the correct division code for your teams. For cheer teams, please use the letters of the code first, followed by the number of the USASF skill level in which you will compete.

**For example: Junior Co-Ed Level 5 shows the letters "JRC" in the chart above, so add a "5" to those letters to indicate you want Junior Co-Ed Level 5— like this: "JRC5". Another example: Senior Open All-Girl Level 6 be noted as "SOA6".**

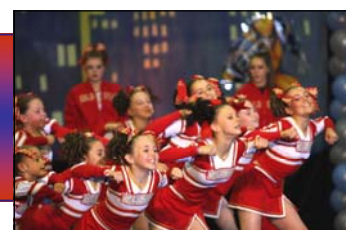
In addition to safety rules, the Future Cheer Rule Book will provide useful information such as:

2. **Online via PayPal on the Future Cheer website: (Dependent on availability after advance tickets from registration packs are processed.)** To give priority to competing teams (who can purchase tickets within registration packs), online ticket sales for any event will not be made available until the registration deadline has passed. **Tickets purchased on PayPal will incur an admin fee of £1.00 per ticket.** Tickets will be available for pick-up on the day of the competition.
3. **At the door via cash or credit card: (Dependent upon availability after advance tickets from registration packs and online tickets are processed.)** Availability of tickets on the door will vary from event to event and even from day-to-day in a single event.
